Requirements:

- You must meet the age requirements as stated on the application and have a Cochranton address or attend Cochranton Schools
- Your term will be for one year, but you may re-apply each year until you turn 19
- It is mandatory you **attend** meetings when they are called. Excused absences or exceptions will be determined by the Junior Board Advisors and Board of Directors liaison
- It is expected that you will promote the fair in a positive manner, use appropriate dress, behavior, and language as you represent the Cochranton Fair.
- You will be required to work a set amount of hours during fair week as well as on committees. Those will be explained to you.
- You must serve on at least one committee
- You may be removed at any time during the year for inappropriate, unacceptable behavior or for not fulfilling your duties
- Attend two Senior Fair Board Meetings a year
- Always display a professional attitude when interacting with fair attendees
- Work with members of the Senior Fair Board when help is needed
- Support the decisions, policies and activities of the Junior Fair Board and the Board of Directors of the Cochranton Community Fair
- Know all the board members and be willing to assist them if needed
