Qualifications

- Have a Cochranton address or attend a Cochranton School
- Be between the ages of 14-19 as of July 1st
- Be able to fulfill a one-year term as a Junior Fair Board member. You may reapply each year until you turn 19
- Complete the Junior Fair Board application including signed parent/guardian consent
- Have 2 signed letters of recommendation from a non-family members

The Junior Fair Board will be under the direction of advisors. Besides supporting various projects of the Junior Fair Board the Board will perform duties during fair week.

Responsibilities would include promoting the fair in a positive manner and provide a positive educational opportunity to all that attend, to maintain a professional and cooperative attitude with fair attendees, Fair Board members, and volunteers, support decisions, policies and activities of both Boards; attend a minimum of 6 Junior Fair Board meetings and 2 regular Board meetings; working a minimum number of hours/days during the fair as scheduled by advisors plus other responsibilities; and assisting with promoting the fair.
