The Junior Fair Board is under the direction of the Fair Board and its Advisors.

Responsibilities include promoting the fair in a positive manner and providing a positive educational opportunity to all that attend, to maintain a professional and cooperative attitude with fair attendees, Fair Board members and volunteers, support decisions, policies and activities of both Boards, attend a minimum of 6 Junior Fair Board meetings and 2 regular Board meetings and working a minimum number of hours/days during the fair as scheduled by advisors.

Qualifications are to have a Cochranton address or attend a Cochranton School, be between the ages of 14-19 as of July 1st, be able to fulfill a one-year term as a Junior Fair Board member, complete the Junior Fair Board application including Signed parent/guardian consent, and have 2 signed letters of recommendation from non-family members.

This year has been unusual due to the cancelling of the Cochranton Community Fair, but the Junior Fair Board has been busy supporting the community by creating free events like the Chalk Walk and soon “Art in the Trees” at Lion’s Park. Tentatively the Gingerbread House Competition will be held November 5 – 7 at the Cochranton Fire Hall.
